PROJECTS SUBMISSION / SELECTION:

- **Projects may be submitted** by any commissioning editor belonging to an <u>EBU Member</u> **or** by any independent producer provided that a letter of intent signed by a commissioning editor belonging to an EBU member is attached to the submission. **Commissioning Editors' presence at the pitch is compulsory.**
- Project proposals are to be sent to simha@ebu.ch no later than 21 April 2015 (Please use the form below and feel free to add max four additional pages. No need for trailer at that stage.)
- **The selection of the 7 projects** to be pitched in La Rochelle will be made by elected Members from the Eurovision Science & Knowledge group beginning of May, on the basis of the following **criteria**:
 - Originality
 - Relevance
 - International appeal
 - Feasibility
 - A special attention will be given to projects that have a cross media approach.
- Broadcasters and Producers of selected projects will be informed of the selection during the first half of May (and will benefit from One to One meetings with Decision Makers organised by Sunny Side after their pitch.)

TRAILERS (compulsory once projects are selected):

- Trailers will have to be made available directly to Sunny Side (DVD or downloadable files) by no later than Mid May 2016. For more information about Material Delivery, please email directly the Sunny Side's Sales team
- Maximum duration: 3 minutes as part of the 14' pitch (7' pitch (incl. trailer) + 7' Q/A)
- Max. Weight: 1 GB. Formats accepted: .mov, .avi, .mp4 (.m4v is not accepted). Please use Firefox or Google Chrome to upload your video. Safari is not recommended.
- Broadcasters / Producers are also required to bring it directly to the event on the day of the pitch.
- Please note that you'll also need to upload various elements (synopsis, treatment, budget...) on the website of the Sunny Side.
